As a child of immigrants, Attorney Ral Obioha understands the hardships immigrants and refugees face in their quest to make a better life for their families and adjust to life in the United States. As such, as an Ode to her parents, Victor and Oby, who had the foresight to immigrate her to the United States, The Law Office of Ral Obioha, PLLC is committed to inspiring and empowering students who are immigrants, have immigrant parents, or who aspire to pursue career paths that focus on improving the lives of immigrants in America. It is our goal to honor the contributions of immigrants and children of immigrants to the United States.

Under the Vic & Oby Scholarship fund, The Law Office of Ral Obioha, PLLC provides financial awards to low-income immigrant college and graduate students who live and/or attend school in any state in the United States. We provide an annual scholarship of up to \$5,000 to cover tuition and other expenses for selected college and/or law school students.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Recipients are selected based on their academic excellence, merits, financial need, and community impact.

In order to be eligible for the Vic & Oby scholarship, an applicant must:

• Be Foreign-born or have foreign-born parents.

- Be accepted into, or is enrolled in, an accredited College, University, Graduate School, Medical School or Law School in the United States for the upcoming school year.
- · Have a Financial need.
- Have a Minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA.
- Demonstrate academic preparation and community/extracurricular involvement.
- Use scholarship fund entirely for college, undergraduate or law school tuition and related expenses.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS*

*Required

- ✓ A completed Vic & Oby Scholarship Application Form*
- ✓ Proof of Identity*
 - The following documents are acceptable identification documents: birth certificate, passport, permanent resident card, unexpired and valid I-94, and last-issued visa. School IDs are not acceptable for this purpose.
- ✓ An acceptance letter from an accredited college, university, graduate school, medical school or law school within the United States*
 - This is required only if you will be a freshman in the upcoming school year.
 It is not required if you're already enrolled.
- ✓ School transcript or Bachelor's degree and transcripts from an accredited college, with minimum unweighted and cumulative 3.0 GPA. *
- ✓ Any evidence of financial need
 - o Examples include federal tax returns, W-2 statements, medical bills, etc.
- ✓ Personal statement *
 - The Personal statement should discuss the positive values the Applicant has drawn from being an immigrant in the U.S. and how the Applicant intends to use those values to create a better life for themselves and/or their family.
 - The Personal Statement should be typed, 1-2 pages, double-spaced, using 1" by 1" margins, and 12-point font size.
- ✓ Proof of current immigrant status (i.e. copy of visa, birth certificate, lawful permanent resident card, or naturalization certificate)

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Download and complete the Vic & Oby Scholarship Application Form
- 2. A counselor, advisor, or principal must complete and sign the bottom portion of the application form on the last page. For college and graduate students, an academic advisor or professor from the department which you majored in may also complete and this section. Electronic signatures are accepted.
- 3. The applicant must submit the completed and signed application alongside supporting documents:

- 4. Applications will begin to be accepted on the 29th day of March.
- 5. All Applications must be received no later than **the 15th day of July.** All applications must be received no later than 11:59 p.m. Central Standard Time on July 15th, in order to be considered.
- 6. A final decision will be made based on scholarship, achievement, and need. The recipient will be notified before the end of August.
- 7. In August, the award checks will be issued, made payable to, and mailed to the recipients' indicated college, university or institution for his or her use.
